Classroom organisation

- Mr Prichard is the class teacher, and Miss Barnett is the Teaching Assistant. We are also supported in our sessions by Miss Pashley.
- Mrs McLaughlin is the Learning Supervisor, who will normally cover the class on a Thursday.
- P.E. is on a Wednesday and Thursday afternoon. So please ensure that your child has the correct P.E. kit (black shorts, red t-shirt and plimsolls or trainers) in school all the time. Your kit should be taken home to wash at the end of each week. If your child is unable to do PE for any medical reason, please send in a letter in advance.
- Please ensure that all items of clothing are named and that any borrowed uniform is returned to us once it is washed.
- All children are expected to behave appropriately at all times and be good role models.
- Every child has a reading record and will need to bring this in every day. We expect the children to read at home 5 times each week. Please help your child achieve this.
- We have all the resources children will need for learning in the classroom, so please leave pencil cases at home.
- Mrs Grant will continue to teach the children music on a Monday.

Homework

- Your child will be given a special homework menu at the start of each half term. On it will be a selection of tasks relating to our curriculum. Every child is expected to complete at least 1 of these tasks by the end of the half term.
- Children will also be asked to learn spellings and times tables each week and will be tested every FRIDAY.
- Please support your child's progress in reading by ensuring they read **EVERY** day and communicating in the yellow Reading Record book.
- Library books will be changed on Thursdays and are for you to enjoy together. Children have also been invited to borrow from the class library and are expected to treat all books borrowed with respect and care.

Punctuality and absence

- Classes start working at 8.55 am and doors open at 8.50am so please ensure that your child is in school on time.
- Please do not take holiday during term time as this will not be authorised.
