<b>Reading</b>	Daily	Please read at home daily. This could be a shared read with a member of your family, an opportunity for you to read to an adult as well as time to quietly read and enjoy a good book on your own. Please record this in your reading record. Your reading record should be signed weekly by an adult, and you should bring it to school daily with your reading book
<b>Maths</b>	Daily	By Year 6, children should practice all times tables and division facts up to 12 x12. You can use chanting, singing, copying out the tables or practise using online games and apps. <b>Spellings</b>	Daily	Look at the spelling list and practise the spellings. Can you put these spellings into sentences? When reading, look out for words with our spelling pattern and add them to the list. Use your home learning book to practise your spellings. .
<b>Handwriting</b>	<b>Whenever you are writing in your Home Learning Book</b>	Use your spelling homework to practise your best handwriting. Remember to use an appropriate writing utensil - a sharpened pencil or a biro pen.
