Learning book

During this half term we will be exploring who we are. We are investigating land use changes in Leavesden and the development of flight. In Science this term we are learning all about the human body. We will investigate what diet we need to be healthy and how bones and muscles work. Our book for English this term is War and Peas - a fable about two kings. We will also be reading The Queen's Nose in our Reading lessons, a fun story about a magical coin and some wishes. Reading	Daily	Please read at home daily. This could be a shared read with a member of your family, an opportunity for you to read to an adult in your family as well as time to quietly read and enjoy a good book on your own. Please record all reading in your reading record and bring this to the school daily. We expect this to be read four times.					
Maths	Daily	In Year 3, children should practise the 3, 4 and 8 times tables up to 12 x 3, 4 and 8 and corresponding division facts (e.g. 24 ÷ 4 = 6). You can use chanting, singing, copying out the tables or practise using online games and apps. Spelling	Daily	Look at the spelling list and practise the spellings. Put these spellings into sentences each week and practice for your test. When reading look out for words with our spelling pattern and add them to the list. Use your home learning book to practise your spellings.					
Handwriting	Whenever you're writing in your Home	Use your spelling homework to practise your best handwriting. Remember to use an appropriate writing utensil (e.g. sharp pencil or black biro pen).
